Our practice resonates with childcare theory including Dyadic Developmental Psychotherapy, Attachment Theory, Social Pedagogy and Opportunity led Life Space Interventions.

Horizons actively promote and uphold the rights and views of our young people and harness all forms of advocacy to ensure the voices of our young people are heard.

Horizons provide, as standard, a staffing ratio of 1:1 who are competent and confident in working alongside young people with complex and challenging behaviours. Our organisation supports young people who present with social, emotional or behavioural difficulties. Our children and young people may also present with a range of additional support needs, for eg. Autism, Aspergers, Attention Deficit Disorders, Learning and Communication Difficulties / Disabilities.

As a team, we are committed to ensure that every intervention provides a positive step to support our young people to develop coping mechanisms to resolve past experiences and develop life skills, self-esteem, confidence and resilience. Our practice also incorporates family work to support sustained, positive contact.
